#### **GENERAL PERSONNEL POLICY**

ALL ATHLETIC PERSONNEL WILL FOLLOW NCHSAA GUIDELINES INCLUDING: • SELF-SCREEN REPORTING

- FACIAL COVERING DIRECTIVES
- SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICIES
- DETAILED PRACTICE PLANS FOR GROUP ACTIVITIES THAT MAY BE NEEDED FOR CONTACT TRACING
- SANITATION OF EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES DAILY.

#### FOOTBALL / FIELD HOUSE PROTOCOLS

<u>ENTRY AND EXIT FACILITY-</u> All athletes should wear a face covering at all times, unless the athlete is actively exercising. LMS football players will enter the Fieldhouse through the 2nd side door. Players will enter their lockers, if needed, while inside the facility. Players will exit the Fieldhouse through the 1st side door. Players will enter the practice field through the gate closest to the Fieldhouse.

<u>REQUIRED SCREENING-</u> All staff will be required to self-screen and take their temperature(<100.4 F) for Covid-19. Coach or designated screener will screen DAILY using the NCHSAA COVID-19 Athlete/Coach/ Staff Daily Monitoring Form. The same process will take place for any workouts. Parents or Visitors (if allowed) will need to be screened before they are allowed to access any areas on campus.

<u>FIELDHOUSE AND LOCKER ROOM PROCEDURES-</u> We will have hand sanitizer and soap readily available in these areas. These areas will be sanitized at the beginning of the day and at the end of the day. Coaches will sanitize their lockers and football equipment each day. A Coach will be assigned to monitor each locker room to ensure athletes are following protocols. All athletes will be required to wear face coverings inside the locker room.

<u>LAUNDRY PROCEDURES-</u> Players will be required to take home all of their cloth items and wash them and bring them back daily. Football uniforms and practice uniforms will be washed and sanitized by the coaching staff.





<u>BUS TRANSPORTATION</u>. Athletes will be transported to games one to a seat, with the exception of athletes who live in the same household. Face coverings are required on the bus. Hand sanitizer will be available as athletes get on and off the bus. Windows on the bus will be down, as long as weather permits.

<u>PRACTICE PROCEDURES</u>- Athletes will be required to have all of their practice equipment and mask to wear during practice and games. Players will bring their own water to practice each day (> 1 gal.). All football equipment used at practice will be sanitized after use. Coaches will follow current guidance mandated at that time pertaining to practice length, pods, mask use, etc.

#### FOOTBALL GAME DAY PROCEDURES

- Athletes must wear a face covering during the game unless they are on the field playing.
- Fans and spectators will not be allowed on the field and all fans/spectators must wear a face covering.
- All fans must exit the stadium immediately after the contest.
- Parents will need to wait for their athlete outside the stadium gates.
- No loitering will be allowed by the concession stand area.

#### VOLLEYBALL / BASKETBALL / GYM SPORTS PROTOCOL

<u>ENTRY AND EXIT FACILITY-</u> Athletes will enter and exit the gym through the doors within the building. Visiting teams will not have access to the locker rooms. Visiting teams will be screened prior to arrival. Officials will be screened and put in the locker room (if allowed) as assigned by the Athletic Director. All spectators and officials will enter and exit the gym through the side gym doors.

<u>REQUIRED SCREENING-</u> All staff, players, coaches, and officials will be required to get screened and have their temperature (<100.4 F) recorded. The Coach or designated screener will screen **DAILY** using the NCHSAA COVID-19 Athlete/Coach/ Staff Daily Monitoring Form.

<u>GYM AND LOCKER ROOM PROCEDURES-</u> Hand sanitizer and soap will be readily available in these areas. These areas will be sanitized at the beginning of the day and at the end of the day by our custodial staff and Athletics Department. Coaches will sanitize the lockers and any equipment used daily. A Coach will be assigned to monitor each locker room to ensure athletes are following protocols. All athletes will be required to wear face coverings inside the locker room.

<u>BUS TRANSPORTATION</u>. Athletes will be transported to games one to a seat, with the exception of athletes who live in the same household. Face coverings are required on the bus. Hand sanitizer will be available as athletes get on and off the bus. Windows on the bus will be down, as long as weather permits.

<u>LAUNDRY PROCEDURES-</u> Players will be required to take home practice clothes unless otherwise stated by Coach and wash them daily. Coaches will wash and sanitize uniforms, warm ups, and any other game items.

<u>PRACTICE PROCEDURES-</u> All athletes should always wear a face covering, unless the athlete is actively exercising. Players will bring their own water to practice each day. Coaches will follow current guidance mandated at that time pertaining to practice length, pods, mask use, etc.





<u>GAME DAY PROCEDURES - A</u>thletes must wear a face covering during the game unless they are on the court playing (Subject to change). Players will be required to bring their own water container to all games, home and away. The Athletic Trainer will set up a "refill station" and set a designated staff or Coach to refill their water if needed for home games.

#### SOCCER AND BASEBALL PROTOCOL

ENTRY AND EXIT FACILITY- Athletes will enter and exit the Practice field through the side gate.

<u>REQUIRED SCREENING-</u> All staff, players, and coaches will be required to get screened and have their temperature (<100.4 F) recorded. The Coach or designated screener will screen DAILY using the NCHSAA COVID-19 Athlete/Coach/ Staff Daily Monitoring Form.

<u>FIELD AND BATHROOM PROCEDURES-</u> Hand sanitizer and soap will be readily available in these areas. These areas will be sanitized at the beginning of the day and at the end of the day by Coaches. Coaches will sanitize the barns, port-a-john, batting cages, and any equipment used daily. A Coach will be assigned to monitor practice to ensure athletes are following protocols. All athletes will be required to wear face coverings when not participating.

<u>BUS TRANSPORTATION</u>. Athletes will be transported to games one to a seat, with the exception of athletes who live in the same household. Face coverings are required on the bus. Hand sanitizer will be available as athletes get on and off the bus. Windows on the bus will be down, as long as weather permits.

<u>LAUNDRY PROCEDURES-</u> Players will be required to take home practice clothes unless otherwise stated by Coach and wash them daily. Coaches will wash and sanitize uniforms, and any other game items.

<u>PRACTICE PROCEDURES</u>- All athletes should always wear a face covering, unless the athlete is actively exercising. Players will bring their own water to practice each day. Coaches will follow current guidance mandated at that time pertaining to practice length, pods, mask use, etc.

<u>GAME DAY PROCEDURES</u> - Athletes must wear a face covering during the game unless they are on the field playing (Subject to change). Players will be required to bring their own water container to all games, home and away. For further soccer game day procedures see stadium procedures.

<u>BASEBALL GAME DAY PROCEDURES-</u> Athletes will enter and exit the Holt-Moffit through the front or back gate. Visiting teams will be screened prior to arrival. Officials will be screened. All spectators and officials will enter and exit the stadium through the front gate.

- Fans and spectators will not be allowed on the field and all fans/spectators must wear a face covering.
- All fans must exit the stadium immediately after the contest.
- Athletes must wear a face covering during the game unless they are on the field playing.
- No Parents allowed near the Dugouts or player areas.
- Parents will need to wait for their athlete outside the stadium gates.
- No loitering will be allowed by the concession stand area (if available)





#### WRESTLING PROTOCOL

ENTRY AND EXIT FACILITY- Athletes will enter and exit the wrestling room through the door of the wrestling room.

<u>REQUIRED SCREENING-</u> All staff, players, and coaches will be required to get screened and have their temperature (<100.4 F) recorded. The Coach or designated screener will screen DAILY using the NCHSAA COVID-19 Athlete/Coach/ Staff Daily Monitoring Form.

<u>WRESTLING ROOM AND BATHROOM PROCEDURES-</u> Hand sanitizer and soap will be readily available in these areas. These areas will be sanitized at the beginning of the day and at the end of the day by Coaches and Athletic Department. Coaches will sanitize the mats, bathrooms, and any equipment used daily. A Coach will be assigned to monitor practice to ensure athletes are following protocols. All athletes will be required to wear face coverings when not participating.

<u>BUS TRANSPORTATION-</u> Athletes will be transported to games one to a seat, with the exception of athletes who live in the same household. Face coverings are required on the bus. Hand sanitizer will be available as athletes get on and off the bus. Windows on the bus will be down, as long as weather permits.

<u>LAUNDRY PROCEDURES-</u> Players will be required to take home practice clothes unless otherwise stated by Coach and wash them daily. Coaches will wash and sanitize uniforms, and any other game items.

<u>PRACTICE PROCEDURES-</u> All athletes should always wear a face covering, unless the athlete is actively exercising. Players will bring their own water to practice each day. Coaches will follow current guidance mandated at that time pertaining to practice length, pods, mask use, etc.

WRESTLING GAME DAY PROCEDURES- See Gym sports game day protocol for further information.

- Weigh Ins will take place in the blue room
- Players will be screened prior to weigh ins
- Mats will be disinfected before and after matches
- Players must bring their own water
- Fans and spectators will NOT be allowed in the player areas
- Visiting team will be screened PRIOR to arrival.

#### **TENNIS PROTOCOLS**

<u>ENTRY AND EXIT FACILITY-</u> Athletes will enter and exit the tennis courts through the front gate. If needed access to the tennis center should be limited. No more than 5 people allowed in at a time. No Fans or Spectators will be allowed in the tennis center.

<u>REQUIRED SCREENING-</u> All staff, players, and coaches will be required to get screened and have their temperature (<100.4 F) recorded. The Coach or designated screener will screen DAILY using the NCHSAA COVID-19 Athlete/Coach/ Staff Daily Monitoring Form.

<u>COURTS AND BATHROOM PROCEDURES-</u> Hand sanitizer and soap will be readily available in these areas. These areas will be sanitized at the beginning of the day and at the end of the day by Coaches and the Athletic Department. Coaches will sanitize the bathrooms, tables, and equipment used daily. A coach will be assigned to ensure athletes are following protocols. All athletes will be required to wear face coverings when not participating.





<u>BUS TRANSPORTATION-</u> Athletes will be transported to games one to a seat, with the exception of athletes who live in the same household. Face coverings are required on the bus. Hand sanitizer will be available as athletes get on and off the bus. Windows on the bus will be down, as long as weather permits.

<u>LAUNDRY PROCEDURES</u>- Players will be required to take home practice clothes and wash them daily. Coaches will wash and sanitize uniforms, and any other game items. (Athletes may be responsible for washing their own uniforms)

<u>PRACTICE PROCEDURES-</u> All athletes should always wear a face covering, unless the athlete is actively exercising. Players will bring their own water to practice each day. Coaches will follow current guidance mandated at that time pertaining to practice length, pods, mask use, etc.

<u>GAME DAY PROCEDURES</u> - Athletes must wear a face covering during the game unless they are on the courts playing (Subject to change). Players will be required to bring their own water to all games, home and away. (>40oz) Spectators must have on a face covering and maintain 6 feet of social distance. Visiting teams will be screened PRIOR to arrival.

#### TRACK/CROSS COUNTRY PROTOCOLS

<u>ENTRY AND EXIT FACILITY-</u> All athletes should wear a face covering at all times, unless the athlete is actively exercising. Athletes will enter through the HOME stadium entrance. Players will enter the Fieldhouse through the front entrance and exit the Fieldhouse through the front entrance. Players will enter and exit through the HOME stadium exit at the end of practice.

<u>REQUIRED SCREENING-</u> All staff will be required to self-screen and take their temperature(<100.4 F) for Covid-19. Coach or designated screener will screen DAILY using the NCHSAA COVID-19 Athlete/Coach/ Staff Daily Monitoring Form. The same process will take place for Strength and Conditioning. Parents or Visitors (if allowed) will need to be screened before they are allowed to access any areas on campus.

<u>FIELDHOUSE AND LOCKER ROOM PROCEDURES-</u> We will have hand sanitizer, soap and readily available in these areas. These areas will be sanitized at the beginning of the day and at the end of the day. Coaches will sanitize equipment each day. A Coach will be assigned to monitor the fieldhouse and track to ensure athletes are following protocols. All athletes will be required to wear face coverings inside the fieldhouse.

<u>BUS TRANSPORTATION</u>. Athletes will be transported to games one to a seat, with the exception of athletes who live in the same household. Face coverings are required on the bus. Hand sanitizer will be available as athletes get on and off the bus. Windows on the bus will be down, as long as weather permits.

<u>LAUNDRY PROCEDURES-</u> Players will be required to take home practice clothes and wash them daily. Coaches will wash and sanitize uniforms, and any other game items. (Athletes may be responsible for washing their own uniforms)

<u>PRACTICE PROCEDURES-</u> All athletes should always wear a face covering, unless the athlete is actively exercising. Players will bring their own water to practice each day. Coaches will follow current guidance mandated at that time pertaining to practice length, pods, mask use, etc.





<u>GAME DAY PROCEDURES-</u> Track see stadium guidelines. Visiting team will be screened PRIOR to arrival. Cross Country will follow the guidelines set by the venue that they travel to. Prior to departure athletes will be screened.

#### SOFTBALL PROTOCOL

ENTRY AND EXIT FACILITY- Athletes will enter and exit the Practice field through the side gate facing the tennis center.

<u>REQUIRED SCREENING-</u> All staff, players, and coaches will be required to get screened and have their temperature (<100.4 F) recorded. The Coach or designated screener will screen DAILY using the NCHSAA COVID-19 Athlete/Coach/ Staff Daily Monitoring Form.

<u>FIELD AND BATHROOM PROCEDURES-</u> Hand sanitizer and soap will be readily available in these areas. These areas will be sanitized at the beginning of the day and at the end of the day by Coaches. Coaches will sanitize the barns, batting cages, and any equipment used daily. A Coach will be assigned to monitor practice to ensure athletes are following protocols. All athletes will be required to wear face coverings when not participating.

<u>BUS TRANSPORTATION</u>. Athletes will be transported to games one to a seat, with the exception of athletes who live in the same household. Face coverings are required on the bus. Hand sanitizer will be available as athletes get on and off the bus. Windows on the bus will be down, as long as weather permits.

<u>LAUNDRY PROCEDURES-</u> Players will be required to take home practice clothes unless otherwise stated by Coach and wash them daily. Coaches will wash and sanitize uniforms, and any other game items. (Athletes may be responsible for washing their own uniforms)

<u>PRACTICE PROCEDURES-</u> All athletes should always wear a face covering, unless the athlete is actively exercising. Players will bring their own water to practice each day. Coaches will follow current guidance mandated at that time pertaining to practice length, pods, mask use, etc

<u>SOFTBALL GAME DAY PROCEDURES-</u> Athletes will enter and exit Finch Park through the home side dugout. Visiting teams will be screened prior to arrival. Officials will be screened. All spectators must maintain 6 feet social distancing. Visiting teams will enter through the visitor dugout.

- Fans and spectators will not be allowed on the field and all fans/spectators must wear a face covering.
- All fans must exit the area of play immediately after the contest.
- No Parents allowed near the Dugouts or player areas.
- Parents will need to wait for their athlete in their vehicles
- No loitering will be allowed by the concession stand area (if available)
- Athletes must wear a face covering during the game unless they are on the field playing.





#### LMS SPORTS MEDICINE SERVICES

Lexington Middle School shares an athletic trainer with Lexington Senior High School. The Athletic Trainer will be available upon request.

#### SAFETY PROTOCOLS INCLUDE:

- Screening of athletes will be completed by the Coaches and Athletic Director.
- The use of hand sanitizer or washing upon entry and exit of the facility.
- The athletic trainer will wear appropriate PPE, including masks.
- Students will need to enter the front door and exit from the rear door.

- Doors will remain locked and signs will be posted to remind of PPE and sanitation requirements.

- In-season athletes will be given priority for rehab and treatment times to reflect their practice/competition scheduled. Out-of-season athletes will need to make an appointment via email or Coach.
- No outside visitors, unless they are essential to care and screened. This includes parents and coaches.
- Opposing teams will not have access to the Athletic Training Room for anything outside of urgent or emergent injury.

#### **DISTANCING PROCEDURES:**

- Where needed, furniture will be moved or blocked off to help ensure proper distancing.
- Signs will be posted and verbal reminders will be given to remind athletes of social distance.

#### **HYDRATION FOR TEAMS:**

Hydration services will be much more limited than in the past. For inside and limited contact sports, teams will rely on players bringing personal water bottles. There will be limited availability for refiling to occur so insulated containers of 64 oz. or greater are recommended.

#### **TREATMENT PRECAUTIONS:**

- Both clinician and patient will be required to wear masks for the duration of the visit.
- Disposable gloves will be worn when evaluating or treating athletes and hand sanitization will be utilized between patients.
- Athletes will be required to wash hands upon entry to the AT Room.
- Athletic Trainers will sanitize tables and equipment between patients.

**CARE FOR INDIVIDUALS EXHIBITING COVID-19 SYMPTOMS:** When screening, it is entirely likely that some individual will present with symptoms. In this case, the athletic trainer will initiate all necessary steps to respond. This includes alerting the proper personnel for contact tracing of the infected person.





#### POSITIVE RESPONSE TO SYMPTOM SCREEN

- Athletes or staff members will be referred to their Primary Care Physician.
- Positive cases will be reported to the county health department via the school nursing staff, who will assist in contact tracing and school reporting.

#### **CONTACT TRACING**

- Rosters and practice plans will be utilized to identify those individuals that may have been exposed.
- Exposed individuals will be notified of their exposure and then advised to guarantine themselves.

#### **RETURN TO SPORT OR PLAY**

<u>According to NCHSAA any athlete being treated or monitored for COVID-19 will need written clearance from</u> <u>their treating physician</u>. This clearance *MUST* include explicit language regarding their participation in athletics. See Forms Below.

Athletes may need a progressive return-to-play due to deconditioning and surveillance for prolonged symptoms or organ damage.





#### **STADIUM & GAME OPERATIONS**

- Philpot Stadium will currently allow 100 Fans. (Subject to Change)
- Fans and Spectators will not be able to be seated in consecutive rows. (EVERY OTHER ROW)
- Fans and Spectators will self-screen for Covid-19 prior to purchasing a ticket to the game.
- Tickets will be limited, Gates will open 1-hour prior to start time.
- PA, Scorekeepers, clock runners, chain crew, and other table workers must be screened
- Fans and Spectators are required to wear face coverings.
- Fans and Spectators will NOT be allowed in the Player areas.
- Groups in the stands (no more than 10) must maintain 6ft. apart.
- Signage will be posted throughout the stadium reminding us to maintain social distancing and require masks be worn at all times.

#### **GYM & GAME OPERATIONS**

- LMS Gym will currently allow 25 Fans. (Subject to Change)
- Fans and Spectators will not be able to be seated in consecutive rows. (EVERY OTHER ROW)
- Tickets will be limited. Doors/Gates will open 1 hour prior to start time.
- Fans will **NOT** be allowed in the Player areas and must sit on the opposing side of the players.
- Fans and Spectators will self-screen for Covid-19 prior to purchasing a ticket to the game.
- Fans and Spectators are required to wear face coverings.
- Groups in the stands (no more than 10) must maintain 6ft. apart.
- Signage will be posted throughout the stadium reminding us to maintain social distancing and requiring masks be worn at all times.
- Bleachers and common surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected by custodial staff and the Athletic Department after the contest. Coaches will disinfect equipment after games (balls, chairs, etc.).
- In between games i.e. JV Volleyball and Varsity Volleyball the gym will be cleared and disinfected before the next set of fans are allowed entry.
- Parents will need to wait for their athlete outside of the school and will be required to leave the gym upon the end of the contest.
- No loitering in the gym will be allowed.
- PA, Scorekeepers, clock runners, and other table workers must be screened

#### STUDENT GROUPS

Student groups such as marching band, dance team, drill teams and other groups **approved** by the school district may attend by abiding the following rules:

- 1. These groups should remain separate from the game or contest participants at all times.
- 2. Student group must wear face masks.
- 3. These students should maintain appropriate distancing from the game and contest participants at all times, including when on the sideline.

- Screening protocols should be followed for all concession stand workers.
- Workers are required to wear face coverings and follow proper food handling procedures.
