- a. Sealed proposals will be received from qualified bidders by Lexington City School Board in the Lexington City School Administration Building located at 1010 Fair Street, Lexington, NC 27292 up to 3:00 PM on Tuesday, June 4, 2024, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read for the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment for the 2024 Renovations at Lexington Middle School, 100 Hemstead Street, Lexington, NC 27292.
 - b. The Project includes the following comprehensive renovations as indicated on the drawings:

Exterior Renovations:

New Front Entrance Canopy of fabricated and painted steel, new front entrance driveway, storm water renovations, exterior brick cleaning and sealing, reroofing of Gymnasium Building, Replacement aluminum storefront windows and doors, New sidewalks, steps, ramps, and railings, Site clearing and tree removal and grading, Exterior parking lot gate.

Interior Renovations:

The relocation of the Main School Office, extensive interior painting throughout, new doors and hardware, new flooring, ceilings, toilet partition replacement, gym bleacher replacement, new cabinetry, acoustical ceiling mounted sound baffles around the Media center hallway, 2 wheelchair lifts at non ADA compliant stairs, and auditorium seating replacement,

Work that doesn't affect the student's clean, quiet, calm, and safe environment may be scheduled during school hours with permission for the School Maintenance Director. Night, holiday, and weekend work will be required to complete this project.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>May 22, 2024</u>, <u>beginning at 10:00 A.M.</u> at Lexington Middle School, 100 West Hemstead Street, Lexington, NC 27292 to allow contractors the opportunity to ask questions and/or clarify pertinent issues. **Attendance is highly recommended** for project clarity and to satisfy Contractor's "Good Faith Effort" in recruiting MBE participation.
- 4. All Contractors and Subcontractors must have all required construction licenses under North Carolina State laws governing their respective trades.
- 5. Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check drawn on a bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation in an amount equal to not less than 5% of the proposal. In lieu thereof, a bidder may offer a bid bond of 5% of the bid, executed by a surety company licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds, conditioned that the surety will, upon demand forthwith make payment to the Obligee upon said bond, if the bidder fails to execute the contract in accordance with the bid bond. Upon failure to forthwith make payment, the surety will pay to the Obligee an amount equal to the amount of said bond. Said deposit shall be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in the event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten days after the award, or to give satisfactory surety as required by law. (General Statutes of North Carolina, C0143, Article 85 129).
- 6. Bonds: Separate Performance and Payment Bond will be required for one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.
- 7. Payments will be made at ninety five percent (95%) of approved monthly applications until a maximum of two and one half percent (2.5%) total retainage is reached at 50% completion per N.C.G.S. 143-134.1 (b1)-through (e). Final Certificates and payment will be issued upon acceptance of the work as complete.
- 8. No bid may be withdrawn after time set for receiving bids for a period of forty-five (45) days.
- 9. Lexington City Schools maintains the goal of ten percent (10%) minority participation in all contracts. All bidders are expected to make and document a good faith effort to achieve this goal. **All the required MBE documents are at the end of this project manual.**
- 10. <u>E-VERIFY REQUIREMENTS.</u>

CONTRACTOR shall comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the General Statutes. Further, if CONTRACTOR utilizes a subcontractor, CONTRACTOR shall require the subcontractor to comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the General Statutes.
