# Attendance





**School attendance and class participation are integral parts of academic achievement and the teaching-learning process. Through regular attendance students develop patterns of behavior essential to professional and personal success in life. Regular attendance by every student is mandatory.**





Students are expected to be at school on time and to remain at school until dismissed. During the school day, students are expected to be present at the scheduled starting time for each class and to remain until the class ends.


When a student must be late or leave early, a written excuse signed by a parent/guardian should be presented upon student's arrival at school.





There will be a **maximum of eight (8) absences** allowed for students participating in semester length classes. Students who exceed these absence limits for any reason shall not receive grade/course credit or be promoted (if applicable) to the next grade level unless:

1. A waiver is granted from the attendance policy by the principal for an absence(s) that falls outside the guidelines
2. Attend and successfully complete a program to make up time hour for hour and work missed due to absences



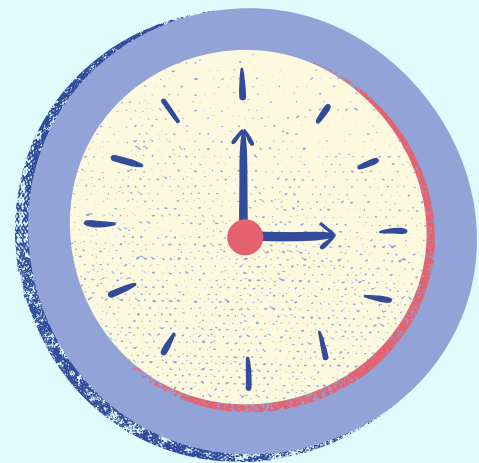
