

Issues that GRG Face

Health Issues

Both mental and physical health issues concerning aging, stress, and trauma in grandchildren

Financial Difficulties

Plans for retirement being derailed, lack of income, economic disadvantages

Social Difficulties


Lack of community and social network, lack of knowledge about resources, lack of access to resources

Language and Technology

Difficulty navigating new technology, lack of language access, lack of being able to decipher language surrounding legal terminology and policies
